White Wines

House Wine

Berri Estates Unoaked Chardonnay, S E Australia £12.75
Fresh and lemony with crisp, ripe acidity and good weight. Fermented and matured in stainless steel with no oak contact to retain the classic Chardonnay varietal fruit.

Pinot Grigio Provincia di Pavia, Italy £13.75
Lovely, buttery style with typical pear fruit. Grapes are Fermented in stainless steel tanks with a long fermentation to enhance the rich style.

Tierra Sauvignon Blanc, Chile £14.00
Pale yellow with fresh fruit, citrus and mineral notes and a clean finish.

Moselland Riesling Kabinett, Germany £15.50
The medium-dry style of this light wine has an edge of crispness and a great potential for ageing. Moselland is an award-winning wine producer.

Chablis, France £28.50
Flowery, lively, fresh and mouth-watering with a crisp fruity palate and that flinty backbone only found in true Chablis oak

Rosé Wine

Hardys Cabernet-Grenache, Australia £12.75
Aromas of ripe strawberries with floral, rose petal overtones. Light-bodied on the palate with soft, sweet berry flavours.

Champagnes

Bouché Père et Fils Cuvée Réservee Brut £30.25
Family passion takes all three grapes from south of Epernay and results in bubbles of baked apple deliciousness.

Perrier-Jouët Grand Brut £47.00
Dry, concentrated and flowery, maturing exceptionally well. A traditional blend of Pinots Noir and Meunier with a touch of Chardonnay.

Berri Estates Merlot, S E Australia £12.75
Several specially selected vineyards provide a delicious combination of raspberries, blueberries and soft plum characters.

Montepulciano d'Abruzzo, Italy £12.75
From the Adriatic Coast around Pescara and Chieti comes this intense ruby-coloured wine with a bouquet reminiscent of violets and oranges.

Chianti Rosso, Italy £16.75
Harmonious and mellow, with violet and red berry notes on a soft and refreshing finish.

Mondavi Woodbridge Shiraz, USA £19.75
Vibrant and concentrated fruit flavours. Fermented in American oak, aromas of lifted dark berry fruits and plums with well-balanced tannins.

Villa Maria Pinot Noir, New Zealand £24.50
Youthful, rich array of ripe berry fruit flavours complemented by fine, savoury tannins and a subtle oak Finish

Sparkling Wines

Cordiniu Clasico Brut Cava, Spain £12.75
Classy, dry, sparkling wine, this renowned House chooses to use the traditional Spanish varieties of Parellada, Xarel-lo and Macabeo.

Prosecco Extra-Dry, Italy £19.75
Fresh, dry and fruity. A pleasant and extremely elegant bouquet with delightful floral-based hints.
